Leave No Trace Trainer Course April 28th – 30th, 2017

Your Invited to what we know will be an exciting and worthwhile educational opportunity. The Boy Scouts of America, and the *Leave No Trace Center for Outdoor Ethics*, are excited to see you become a *Leave No Trace Trainer*.

When – April 28th 6:00pm – 30th 6:00pm, 2017. If the start time is a challenge for you, please contact the instructor listed at the bottom of the page, to see if arrangements can be made for you to arrive when your life permits. All 16 hours of course material coverage is required for graduation.

Where – **Mandan Scout Camp & Training Center**, 11639 Garnett (or Correction Road), Wright, Kansas, 67882, (I would not consider this address entered into a GPS as dependable) the GPS coordinates are N37° 49.5559' W99° 54.9817' at the entrance for the camp. Who – **This course is open to everyone.** Part of the material may be somewhat advanced, and complex for those under age 11. Those under 14 do not always meet the graduation criteria, but all younger past participants have still had a great time, and said they wanted to do it again. All are encouraged to come wither they graduate or not, just for the fun with a purpose, as scouting is supposed to be.

Why & What is it – Outdoor Ethics is second only to Safety/First Aid in Scouting's priority list; It is ranked as a higher priority than advancement in scouting. The Leave No Trace Trainer Course is shortened weekend version of the weeklong master educator course. It provides outdoor, hands on, experiential learning in a camping environment.

Cost/Registration – **\$30.00, & Registration Closes April 26th, 2017.** This covers food and BSA awards. Registration which is done through the Santa Fe Trails Council Office, 1513.5 East Fulton Terrace, Garden City, Kansas. 67846 (620-275-5162), is limited to the first 20 participants, is done on a first come first serve basis (so register sooner than later), and closes April 26th. What you need to bring – **Yourself, your personal gear/stuff/paperwork.** Your clothing, hygiene, camping, and cooking gear (while the food is provided you will be responsible for preparing it), your teaching activity/learning exercise ready to go, something to take notes with is recommended if you desire, and required paperwork (health form, LNT risk waiver, etc.).
